NOKINGS2 Rally October 18, 2025 in Morristown, NJ

[Morristown, NJ] — Saturday, October 18, there will be a rally in Morristown, NJ when New Jersey residents will come together with millions of Americans across the country in a nationwide day of nonviolent protest at the second No Kings Day of Action. There are currently thousands of events nationwide.

NO KINGS is our message to the world that we do not consent to authoritarian excesses and corruption for the benefit of Trump and his billionaire allies. We won't stand by as they crack down on free speech, detain people for political views, disappear people off our streets, and defy the courts. As President Trump continues to pretend he's a dictator, we are standing up again to push back against Trump and his billionaire cronies' hateful, vengeful authoritarian actions and personal gain.

The rally is sponsored by the League of Women Voters of the Morris Area, NJ 11th for Change and local people unaffiliated with organizations who cannot stand by and watch our nation sink into a Constitutional crisis. A full list of national partners can be seen at www.nokings.org/partners.

A speaker at the NOKINGS2 event, Lucy Del Gaudio says, "No Kings Day reminds us that leadership is about service and community, not crowns or titles. As a Latina, a veteran, and an advocate, I believe this day celebrates collective power, democracy, and the truth that no one stands above the people." Lucy is a US Army veteran who has testified in Congress on women's rights and sexual assault in the military.

The NOKINGS2 gathering will take place at Morristown Town Hall, 200 South Street, Morristown, NJ from 11:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 18, 2025. There will be music and speakers who represent leaders, experts, and people whose everyday lives are impacted by the destruction of livelihoods, gutting of public services, and the bullying / fearmongering rhetoric.

Our peaceful day of action will bring together local residents from all walks of life who share a simple message: We don't do kings or dictators in America. No Kings events adhere to a shared commitment to nonviolent protest and community safety. Organizers are trained in de-escalation and are working closely with the Town of Morristown to ensure a peaceful and secure rally.
