**League of Women Voters Mountain Lakes and League of Women Voters Morristown Area
Hosting a Candidates Forum for NJ State Assembly District 25**

Morristown – On Monday, October 28, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. the League of Women Voters of Mountain Lakes and the League of Women Voters Morristown Area are co-sponsoring a moderated forum for the Republican and Democratic challengers who are running for NJ State Assembly District 25 in the November 5, 2019 Election. The forum will be held at the Parish House of The Presbyterian Church in Morristown, 65 South Street, Morristown, NJ 07960. Note that this is not the main church (located on The Morristown Green), but an adjunct church building on South Street.

There are two Republican and two Democratic challengers for two seats representing District 25 in the NJ State Assembly. The Republican candidates are: Anthony M. Bucco (incumbent) and Brian Bergen. The Democratic candidates are: Lisa Bhimani and Darcy Draeger.

The candidates will each provide a background statement and will answer questions provided by the League. There will be time for questions from the public.

In order to ensure impartiality, the moderator Toni Zimmer is a specially trained member of the nonpartisan League of Women Voters New Jersey who does not live within the voting district.

The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan organization which does not endorse or oppose any candidate or political party. The purpose of the League is to promote political responsibility through informed and active participation in government.
